

RESOLUTION NUMBER 18, 2022

Resolution to enter into agreements with three (3) organizations for the Small Business & Ecosystem Grants – Round 2

Whereas, ECGRA’s mission of economic and community development recognizes the importance of revitalizing neighborhoods and main street corridors, combating blight, strengthening small business, and catalyzing innovation;

Whereas, the Economic Development Financing Law recognizes that economic insecurity due to unemployment is at any time a serious menace to the people of the Commonwealth in both urban and rural areas;

Whereas, the Economic Development Financing Law states expressly that entities like ECGRA may have as one of its purposes the alleviation or elimination of unemployment;

Whereas, the three (3) recipients are identified as the following primary applicants: Erie’s Black Wall Street; Impact Corry; and Sisters of St. Joseph Neighborhood Network;

Whereas, the eligible applicants are awarded grants totaling \$280,750 to the extent outlined in the attached Exhibit “A”;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Erie County Gaming Revenue Authority, pursuant to the Economic Development Financing Law and the ECGRA Bylaws, resolves to enter into agreements with three (3) recipients of the Small Business & Ecosystem Grant Program so the communities served may flourish, create an economic impact on the region and continue to improve upon local business on behalf of the people of Erie County.
